


## Highlights from CMOR Behavioral Health Discussion

Do you currently offer BH services in-house or outsource them through a vendor?




For those that currently outsource (4/10):

## Considerations for outsourcing BH

Advice from plan executives

- Rely on BH management companies to keep up with complex state regulations and requirements.
- Outsourcing eliminates the burden on the plan to manage and contract a capable and accessible BH clinician network.
- Push BH management companies to connect BH treatment to medical expenses given that coordination of care is more difficult when outsourcing.
- Consider how use of digital BH tech vendors/apps (e.g., Able To, MAP HealthCare) could fill in gaps like same-day appointment access.



## Considerations for offering BH in-house

Advice from plan executives

- Expand the roles of non-BH clinicians to deliver low acuity care, and recruit internal medical directors to oversee, coordinate, and even deliver BH treatment.
- Devote resources to train internal staff on how to treat and talk about members with low to moderate BH needs.
- Ensure care coordination among relevant departments (e.g., BH and CM) to invoke holistic treatment of behavioral and physical member health.
- Use the right messaging to the market to explain move to in-house (e.g., issue with vendor, experience for members, desire to increase care coordination).
